
About our school

- Maylandsea Primary School is one of 7 schools in the Eveleigh Link Academy Trust all our schools have high expectations of our children and parents. We expect parents to support their children's learning e.g. with homework, parents evening and taking an interest in their education.
- Maylandsea Primary School is moving towards having one class in each year group and 30 children in each class (full capacity 210). Every class has a teacher and a learning support assistant to help with maths and English each morning. The afternoons are mainly the wider curriculum (history, art, music, PE etc) Reception children have a teacher as well as a full time learning support assistant.
- We have 2 large, public carparks near the school but these do get very busy. We encourage families to walk to school where possible.
- We offer a variety of before and after school clubs from Y1 upwards. These may include activities such as tennis, football, gymnastics, music lessons, choir, computer, badminton, science.
- Every week we email home a newsletter with dates and events happening during the school term. It also gives weekly updates of what's been happening in school.



Early Years: Our curriculum is based on developing the characteristics of effective learning. We use the online system called Class Dojo to record each child's learning journey, which

parents can access too.
