Freeze Fridays – ongoing – over £200 so far

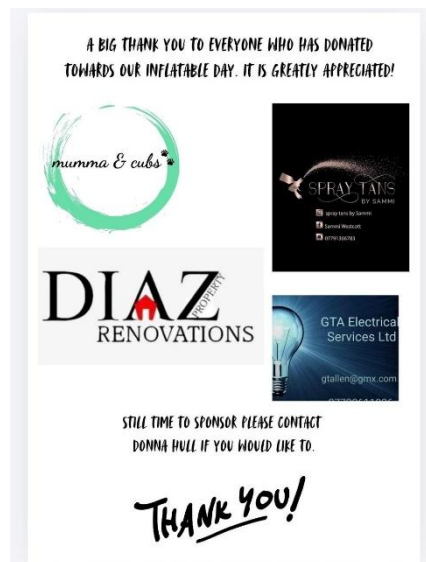
Monies raised this time will be going towards updating the outside stage area.
